OIL SEPARATORS



Special inorganic materials are required for the construction properly functioning oil separators in refrigeration and natural compressor packages. In these units, gases other than air (such as Freon, ammonia or natural gas) are being compressed and mixed with lubricating oil which still must be removed prior to the use of gas. These types of gases, along with ancillary materials often contained in natural gas, are not suitable for typical oil separator construction, and care must be given to the proper selection of all materials in order to ensure proper functioning of the separator.
